Energy Saving measures

- Switch off lights, heaters and air-conditioning units when a room is not being used to avoid wasting energy.
- Keep windows and doors shut when heaters or air-conditioning units are switched on. Make use of natural lighting and natural ventilation where possible.
- Ensure that heaters are not blocked with any furniture to allow the air to circulate freely.
- Don't forget to turn off electrical equipment when not needed.
- Switch off monitors before you go on your lunch break/ home and do not leave equipment on standby as it will continue to consume energy.
- A device that is powered down but left plugged in will still use energy. Ensure that the switch at the socket is turned off.
- Make sure your vehicle, machinery and other equipment are serviced regularly.
- Travel smart – Drive sensibly and avoid unnecessary car journeys. Choose public transport, cycling or walking over car journeys and make use of virtual tools such as Microsoft Teams where possible!
